The Hallsville Boys' Basketball Program is offering its annual Bobcat Basketball Camp, designed to give some basic and advanced insight to the game of basketball.

This camp will emphasize the same fundamentals, concepts and philosophies that are taught to our varsity players. The purpose of the camp is to provide basic skills of shooting, ball-handling, rebounding, defense, and much more. The week will be filled with fun activities as well as healthy competition in the hope that each camper leaves the camp a more knowledgeable and experienced player.

Head Coach Darrin Gleghorn will serve as camp director. Coach Gleghorn was the coach at 2A Woden H.S. for 17 years where he had a record of 434—129. In those 17 years, Woden won 12 District Championships, went to the playoffs 16 times, made 6 trips to the Regional Tournament and one trip to the State Tournament. Last year, he and his coaching staff led the Bobcats to a 21 win season, a Championship at the Spring Hill Tournament and a 13AAAA Playoff spot. This year the Bobcats finished 15-15 while winning the Spring Hill Tournament and finishing second at the Tatum Tourney.
